Resolution 2011-7

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF GRAFTON BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RELATING TO REDISTRICTING, AMENDING THE TOWN CODE OF ORDINANCES AND ADOPTING THE REVISED TOWN WARD MAP

WHEREAS, the federal decennial census of 2010 has been received by the Town of Grafton, and

WHEREAS, the interest of the Town of Grafton is to conform its wards with Ozaukee County's Supervisory Districts, and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Statute § 5.15 requires municipalities with populations between 1,000 to 9,999 to combine wards for the purpose of municipal reporting of election results only if the municipality has adopted a resolution authorizing that combination, and

WHEREAS, Town staff has divided the Town of Grafton into wards making a good faith effort to accommodate the "Tentative Supervisory District Plan" and to create a plan that permits the creation of lawful supervisory districts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. The Town Wards shall be formed into Ozaukee County Supervisory Districts as follows:
 - a. **Ward 1 Population: 769**
Ward 1 will be formed from a portion of County Supervisory District 9 and combined with wards from the Town of Cedarburg and be comprised of census blocks: 4004, 4005, 4006, 4007, 4008, 4009, 4010, 4011, 4014, 4059, 4060, 4061, 4062, 4064, 5014, 5015 and 5016

b. Ward 2 Population: 996

Ward 2 will be formed from a portion of County Supervisory District 10 and be comprised of census blocks: 1017, 1018, 1026, 1027, 1028, 1029, 1030, 1031, 1032, 1033, 1034, 1035, 1036, 1037, 1038, 1039, 1062, 1063, 1064, 1070, 1071, 1072, 4000, 4001, 4002, 4003, 4015, 4016, 4017, 4018, 4019, 4020, 4021, 4023, 4024, 4025, 4026, 4027, 4028, 4029, 4030, 4031, 4032, 4033, 4035, 4036, 4039, 4040, 4042, 5000, 5001, 5002, 5018, 5020, 5021 and 5027

c. Ward 3 Population: 910

Ward 3 will be formed from a portion of County Supervisory District 10 and be comprised of census blocks: 1002, 1003, 1005, 1007, 1008, 1009, 1012, 1013, 1015, 1016, 1041, 1042, 1043, 1044, 1045, 1046, 1047, 1048, 1049, 1050, 1051, 1057, 1058, 1065, 1066, 1067, 2030, 2031 and 2058

d. Ward 4 Population: 1,000


Ward 4 will be formed from a portion of County Supervisory District 10 and be comprised of census blocks: 1068, 1069, 2025, 2026, 2027, 2033, 2034, 2035, 2036, 2037, 2038, 2039, 2040, 2041, 2043, 2044, 2047, 2048, 2049, 2050, 2051, 2052, 2053, 2059, 2060, 3008, 3014, 3015, 3016, 3018, 3019, 3020, 3021, 3028, 3029 and 3030

e. Ward 5 Population: 377

Ward 5 will be formed from a portion of County Supervisory District 13 and be comprised of census blocks: 1059, 1060, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2018, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2024, 2028, 2029, 2032, 2055, 3009, 3010, 3022, 3024, 3025, 5001, 5005, 5006, 5015, 5016, 5018, 5023 and 5024; and

2. The Town Clerk shall report election results to Ozaukee County; and
3. The Town Attorney shall prepare an ordinance amending Title 2, ch. 1, sec. 8, of the Town of Grafton Code of Ordinances, consistent with this Resolution; and
4. The Town Planner and /or the Town Engineer shall modify and revise the Official Ward Map of the Town of Grafton, describing the boundaries of each ward, consistent with this Resolution.
